Dear Members and Friends of Drakestown Church:

It is with sadness that I share the news that after June of this year, I will no longer be your pastor. I have realized for a long time now that I was over extended in trying to balance serving in two distinct and geographically separated ministry settings, but I felt blessed to be here with you and believed, as I still do, that God was using me for important work here at DUMC. As a result, I was reluctant to make a change, even though Ellen and I realized that I and we were paying a price for not doing so. However, a recent health scare impressed upon me that I need to make serious changes for both health and family reasons. As a result, I requested that Bishop Schol appoint me full-time to Meadow Lakes, my other ministry location, as of July 1st, and he has granted my request. I will continue to serve here through the end of this June, and you will receive a new pastor in July.

I hope you will all realize that this was a very difficult decision which Ellen and I have both agonized over. I will dearly miss being here with all of you. I have felt blessed, honored, and privileged to be your pastor and wish it was realistic to continue in that role. Sadly, I realize that I can't keep working the equivalent of 1.5 jobs per week to make the arrangement work as I have been doing. I have been perpetually exhausted for a long time and have not had adequate time to focus on my health. I was hoping to be here another year or two or longer, but I was recently diagnosed with a mild heart condition and I now know that I need to start taking much better care of myself. Therefore, out of necessity, I made the painful decision to leave Drakestown Church.

I came here three and a half years ago to serve as a six-month interim pastor. Our former District superintendent, Steve Bechtold, asked me to help you heal after a period of conflict and begin to move forward as a church again. I was privileged to stay an additional three years, lead you through Covid-19, and walk with you through an extended period of grief as we said goodbye to five precious members, who have gone on to experience God's eternal, loving embrace. I also had the joy of welcoming six new people into our fold and had the exciting opportunity to celebrate Drakestown's 210th anniversary with you as well. I will always fondly remember my time here and the gift of walking in faith with all of you.

Being here has blessed me in many ways. I am humbled by your faith and perseverance. I believe deeply in you and in Drakestown church, and I am sad that I will not be here to help you create the next steps in the church's long, faithful, journey of ministry. However, I trust that our District Superintendent, The Rev. Dr. Eunice Vega Perez and Bishop Schol will find someone very capable to follow me. I pledge to support you and work with whoever you invite to be your new pastor to ensure that the transition goes smoothly.
